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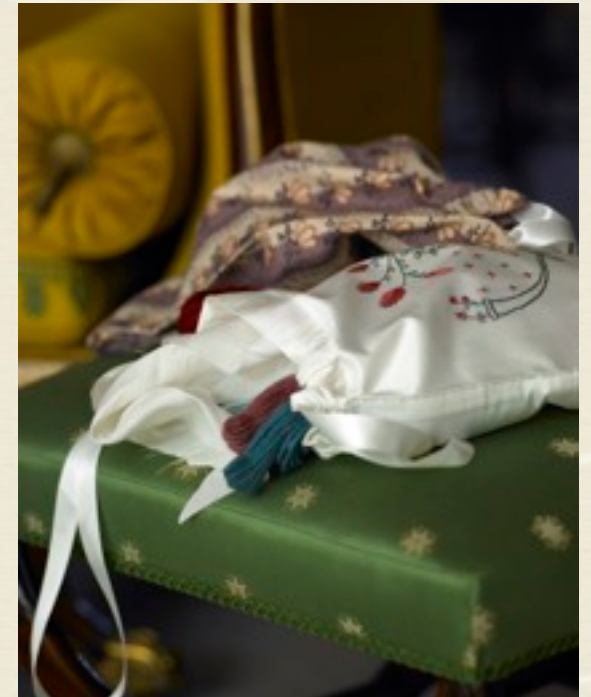

*Applique, carpet work, samplers and cross stitch are also gorgeous Regency projects.*

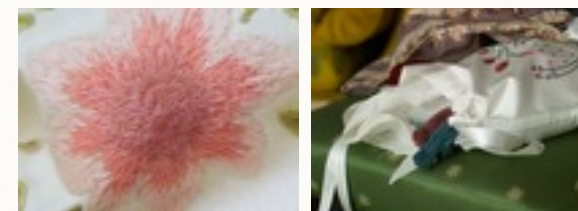
### Class details
